- 1. The audited standalone financial results of the Company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2021 have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (INDAS) as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended.
- 2. The above audited standalone financial results of the Company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2021 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter approved by the Board of Directors at their Meeting held on May 25, 2021. The Statutory Auditors of the Company have audited the results for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2021.
- 3. The Company's business activity falls within a single reportable business segment, viz, Automotive Tyres, Tubes and Flaps.
- 4. The figures for the quarter ended 31st March 2020 and 31st March 2021 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the end of the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 5. The Company has assessed the possible impact of COVID-19 in preparation of the standalone financial results, including but not limited to its assessment of liquidity and going concern assumption, recoverable values of its investments, financial and non-financial assets and impact on revenues and costs. The Company has considered internal and external sources of information and has performed sensitivity analysis on the assumptions used and based on current estimates, expects to recover the carrying amount of these assets.
- 6. There was a claim against the Company in respect of Product Liability in the USA. Claims amounting to Rs.22.16 crores were settled by the Company during the current year. However, being covered by Product Liability Insurance, a sum of Rs.21.93 crores was recovered from the insurer during the current year. Company has classified the net cost of Rs.0.23 crores in the Statement of Profit and Loss as an exceptional item.
- 7. The implementation of the Code on Social Security, 2020 is getting postponed. The Company will assess the impact thereof and give effect in the Financial Statements when the date of implementation of the codes and the Rules / Schemes thereunder are notified.
- 8. The Board of Directors of the company recommended a dividend of Rs. 30 per equity share of Rs. 10/each (i.e.300%) for the year ended March 31st 2021, subject to the approval of shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the company.
- 9. The previous year figures have been regrouped / rearranged to conform to current Quarter / year classification, to be in line with the industry practice. Particularly, this had the effect of:

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TVS SRICHAKRA LIMITED

Report on the Audit of Standalone Financial Results

#### Opinion

- We have audited the accompanying standalone financial results of TVS Srichakra Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
- In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these standalone financial results:
  - a. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard;
  - b. gives a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2021.

#### **Basis for Opinion**

3. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial results under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

#### Management and Board of Directors' Responsibilities for the Standalone Financial Results

 The Statement has been prepared on the basis of the audited standalone financial statements for the year ended 31st March 2021.

The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation of these financial results that give a true and fair view of the net profit/loss and other comprehensive income and other financial information in accordance with Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the standalone financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

5. - 6. Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the standalone financial results as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. - 3. The Holding Company's business activity falls within a single reportable business segment, viz, Automotive Tyres, Tubes and Flaps. The subsidiaries' revenue and assets do not meet the criteria for reportable segment as prescribed in IND AS. Non reportable segments have not been disclosed as unallocated reconciling item in view of their materiality.
- 4. The figures for the quarter ended 31st March 2020 and 31st March 2021 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the end of the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 5. The Group has assessed the possible impact of COVID-19 in preparation of the consolidated financial results, including but not limited to its assessment of liquidity and going concern assumption, recoverable values of its investments, financial and non-financial assets and impact on revenues and costs. The Group has considered internal and external sources of information and has performed sensitivity analysis on the assumptions used and based on current estimates, expects to recover the carrying amount of these assets.
- 6. There was a claim against the Holding Company in respect of Product Liability in the USA. Claims amounting to Rs.22.16 crores were settled by the Holding Company during the current year. However, being covered by Product Liability Insurance, a sum of Rs.21.93 crores was recovered from the insurer during the current year. Holding Company has classified the net cost of Rs.0.23 crores in the Statement of Profit and Loss as an exceptional item.
- 7. The implementation of the Code on Social Security, 2020 is getting postponed. The Group will assess the impact thereof and give effect in the Financial Statements when the date of implementation of the codes and the Rules / Schemes thereunder are notified.
- 8. The Board of Directors of the Holding company recommended a dividend of Rs.30 per equity share of Rs.10/- each (i.e.300%) for the year ended March 31st 2021, subject to the approval of shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the Holding company.
- 9. The previous year figures have been regrouped / rearranged to conform to current Quarter/ year classification, to be in line with the industry practice. Particularly, this had the effect of:

Report on the Audit of Consolidated Financial Results

#### Opinion

- 1.
